

## CONTENTS

The digitalization process of the engineering and construction industry is proceeding among many difficulties, some connected with the overall environment not yet oriented to develop in this direction, some others related with the absence of an exhaustive identification of exact contents embedded in the acronym BIM, which could constitute homogeneous and effective reference for all the entities involved and in all stages of process development.

The Second OICE International Forum on digitalization and BIM, will continue, in line with first Forum held the last year in Milan, the close professional partnership with authoring software houses, and the exchange of experience with international best practices with participation of authoritative representatives from international academic world.

During the Forum the activities of the EFCA Task Force on BIM for the identification of reference guidelines for Exchange Information Requirement (EIR) and BIM Execution Plan (BEP) will be presented together with results of the pilot cases developed within the OICE-BIM Project representatives of the Government institutions, and procurement stations and

entrepreneurship will discuss, in a round table, information management and its impact on digitalization of design and construction processes.

In the afternoon, the software houses will present their own experience mainly focus the attention on CDE and BIM guides and a final review of expected perspectives on design and construction digitalization development will close the Forum.

The Forum is also to promote the definition of an information management body of knowledge as a reference for education, assessment of experience and skills, and development of adequate attitudes towards more structured way of collaboration.

The Forum will highlight the Information Management principles to be considered in the development of adequate Exchange or Employer information requirements and of subsequent efficient BIM Execution Plan (BEP) with an appropriate degree of completeness.

The Forum will also refer to the international taken approach towards a gradual evolution of the existing practices and tools currently in use towards higher level of digitalization.
