January 2019 is the outset for compulsory BIM technology in Italy. Initially applied to public projects exceeding 100 million € it will progressively be extended to all public tendering within 2025.

This road map will engender disrupting effects both on the demand and on the supply side of the industry. The Third edition of the International OICE BIM Forum has the ambition to disseminate the knowledge necessary to fulfil this requirement which constitutes a key factor for clients, designers, contractors and owners involved in the real estate and infrastructure sectors.
